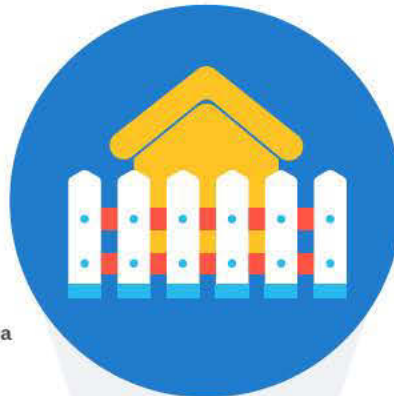
OUR APPROACH

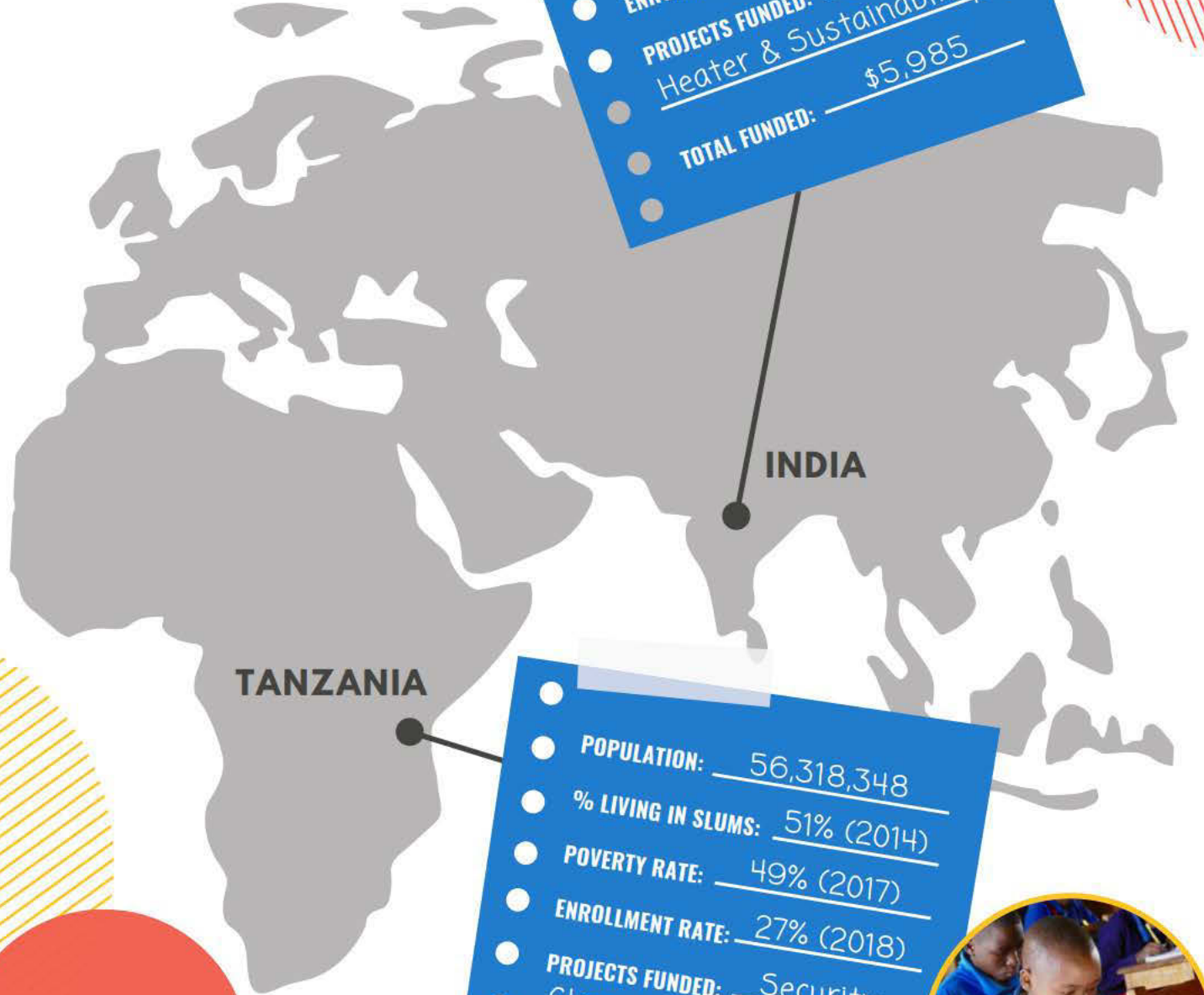

PARTNER SPOTLIGHT: myLIFEspeaks

MyLIFEspeaks is committed to creating a ripple effect throughout the country of Haiti by using sustainable, long-term community development and family-based support methods.

200 Orphanages has been partnering with myLIFEspeaks since 2016 and has helped to fund 4 projects in Neply, Haiti.

In 2019, 200 Orphanages funded the following project with your support:

SUPPLIES FOR SPECIAL EDUCATION CLASS

Focus: Education & Sustainability

MyLIFEspeaks is passionate about providing a higher level of learning and a safe place for special needs and typically developing children to learn and to transform their future and their generation. These children have sadly been outcast by their family, primarily because of the influence of voodoo culture.

200 Orphanages funded the materials needed to set up a new special education classroom in Haiti. The space will serve several of their orphaned children that live on site, as well as other community children with special needs.

PARTNER SPOTLIGHT: ASHIRVAD

Ashirvad Children's Home (Ashirvad meaning "Blessing" in Hindi) provides a home, love, care, physical nourishment and education to neglected, misdirected, abandoned and abused children.

200 Orphanages has been partnering with Ashirvad Children's Home since **2014** and has helped to fund **9** projects in Tuni, east India.

In 2019, 200 Orphanages funded the following projects with your support:

SOLAR WATER HEATER

Focus: Health & Sustainability

The solar water heaters heat the water to allow the 120 children at the orphanage to take warm showers during the winter months when temperatures reach below 50 degrees.

WATER BUFFALO FOR MILK

Focus: Food & Sustainability

The water buffalo provides healthy milk for the children to drink, a safer alternative to the milk in country which is often chemically modified and more expensive.

PARTNER SPOTLIGHT: MAINSPRINGS

MainSprings (formerly the Janada L. Batchalor Foundation) believes no child should have to grow up in extreme poverty and that these children need more than just a home to break the cycles of poverty they face.

200 Orphanages has been partnering with **MainSprings** since **2015** and has helped to fund **7** projects in northern Tanzania.

In 2019, 200 Orphanages funded the following projects with your support:



SECURITY GATE FOR GIRLS

Focus: Safety, Sustainability & Infrastructure

Together, we provided funding to build a security wall surrounding the dormitory blocks and dining hall as well as a security guard for the young girls, ages 4 to 6, living at the MainSprings residential campus.



CLEAN WATER WELL FOR THE COMMUNITY

Focus: Water, Sustainability, Infrastructure & Health

Beyond supplying the campus of 400 children and 70+ staff, the clean water well also provides clean, potable water to the 7,500 community members in the surrounding area.



MAINSRING'S DORM PAVED PATIO

Focus: Infrastructure

This project improved the outdoor open area enclosing the girl's home which will be transformed into a area to read, play and gain an appreciation of the outdoors.

PARTNER SPOTLIGHT: ST. TERESA'S ORPHAN FOUNDATION

St. Teresa's Orphan Foundation's mission is to rescue orphans and vulnerable children from child abuse, child labor, homelessness, child trafficking, drug abuse, crime, prostitution, early pregnancy and premature death by providing them with a safe home, love and education.

200 Orphanages has been partnering with **St. Teresa's** since **2018** and has helped to fund **2** projects in **Songea, Tanzania**.

In 2019, 200 Orphanages has funded the following projects with your support:

CLEAN WATER FOR THE ORPHANS

Focus: Water, Sustainability, Infrastructure & Health

Obtaining and accessing clean water, growing crops and managing livestock in the continuous dry climate continues to be a challenge. This project funded the well, holding tanks, plumbing and a solar water pump on St. Theresa's campus, providing water to the 400 school children, as well as to their hostels, classrooms, laboratories and kitchen and dining areas.



BOY'S DORMITORY

Focus: Shelter, Infrastructure & Sustainability

This project funded the construction of the boy's dormitory for over 60 children who will be able to attend school on site.

PARTNER SPOTLIGHT: NPH INTERNATIONAL

Nuestros Pequeños Hermanos (NPH) is Spanish for "Our Little Brothers and Sisters." They believe that every child needs a family. Whether children that live in a community with a family member or in one of their residential homes, they strive to provide what's best about family: love, security, nourishing food, healthcare, an education and a future.

200 Orphanages has been partnering with **NPH International** since **2009** and has helped to fund **10** projects in Mexico, Guatemala and Haiti.

In 2019, 200 Orphanages has funded the following projects with your support:

1 BEDROOM GUTTERS

Focus: Sustainability

The new gutters divert water away from the walls, minimizing risk of mold and preventing soil erosion.



2 WATERPROOFING FAMILY ROOM

Focus: Health & Sustainability

Waterproofing the family room helps create a healthier home for the children, especially those with existing medical conditions like asthma.

3 COMPUTER ROOM

Focus: Education & Sustainability

200 Orphanages helped expand the modest computer center nearly three times to reach approximately 140 students. The computer center provides the student a place to study, conduct research and homework, and access the internet and other resources.

TANZANIA TONIGHT



On October 22nd, 82 orphan ambassadors gathered at the Holiday Inn and Suites in St. Cloud, Minnesota for our 2nd annual **Tanzania Tonight** benefit to celebrate and support our mission to provide safety and shelter for orphans around the globe. Together, we raised **\$22,225** to build a water well, providing access to safe drinking water for over 400 children and adult caretakers at **St. Teresa's Orphanage** in Songea in southwestern Tanzania.

The evening included a raffle, an African marketplace and a carefully curated menu inspired by Tanzanian culture and cuisine. **100% of donations raised went directly to building the well.**

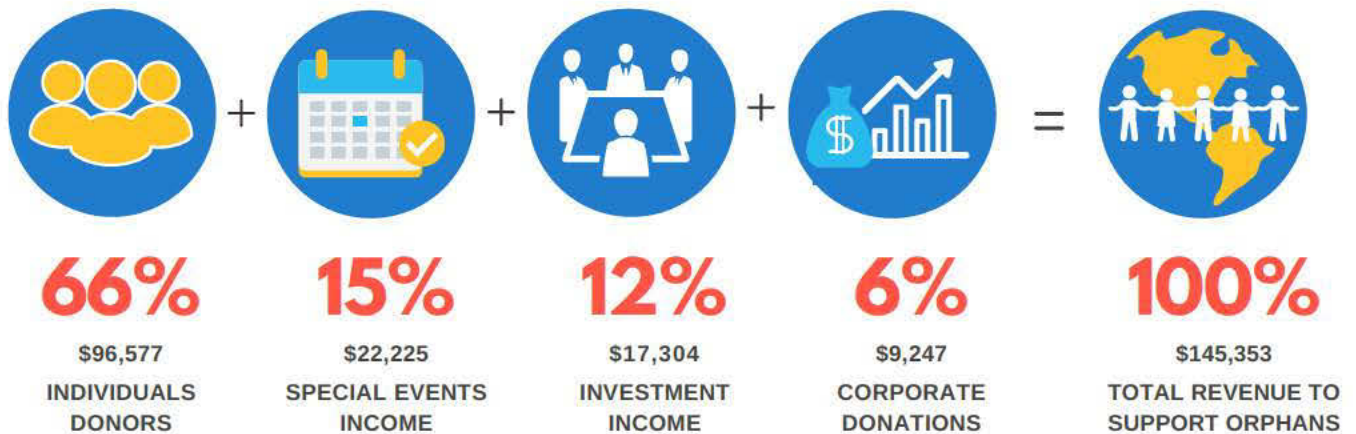

REVENUE



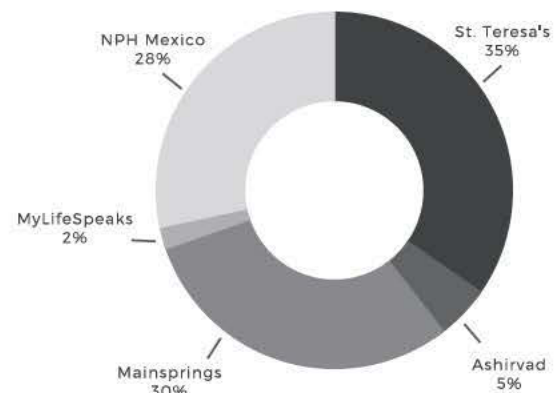
