Our Story

200 Orphanages Worldwide Inc was incorporated in 2007. Jan Hanson, our Founder member, traveled to Peru in January 2007 and while there, she helped build a security wall around a poor neighborhood school. As she stacked mud the flowed, and bricks, tears she was determined to spend her life making a difference in the lives of orphans. She decided to use her 20 years in corporate marketing, and her background as a journalist to help raise awareness and funds to build safe shelter for orphans. In 2008, we began our mission to help raise awareness and funds to provide safety, shelter, and sustainability for orphans.

The organization's primary function is to raise funds for various infrastructure projects that serve orphans. One hundred percent of donations go to the designated project. Since 2007, volunteers and supporters have mobilized to complete nearly 100 projects in 20 countries providing safety, shelter, and sustainability. Children now have dormitories, security walls, outdoor kitchens, libraries, dining halls, school buses, clean water wells, and more.

Today we are a strong and committed team of Board members, Project Managers and volunteers striving to keep with our motto "We can't do it all, but we can all do something".

As a volunteer with us, we also have certain expectations.

- 1. We appreciate attendance and timeliness at scheduled meetings. We also appreciate if volunteers initiate communications and rescheduling when necessary
- 2. We appreciate volunteers carry out assigned tasks efficiently and honestly to the best of their abilities and follow the guidelines provided by the assigned coordinator.
- 3. We value your time and know how busy life can be! We appreciate a time commitment of up to 6-8 hours of volunteering on monthly basis. The schedule is usually very flexible and can be worked out with your assigned coordinator.
